



VBS is partnering with AIM to share the Gospel!



The world is coming to Kentucky for the World Equestrian Games. The games will be held at the Kentucky Horse Park September 25– October 10. More than 300,000 are expected from Kentucky, the United States, Europe and the Middle East. Most of them will not have a relationship with Jesus Christ and many will be from places with little or no gospel witness.

AIM (Affiliated International Ministries) is the organization comprised of churches and related organizations working together to make a positive impact, before, during and after the games.



Trading pins are very popular at the games just as they are popular at the Olympics. Using the theme, More than Gold, volunteers will give the pins away (never in trade). What's worth More than Gold? A relationship with Jesus Christ! The More Than Gold trading pin is a souvenir quality piece and is printed on a gold background. The colors in the logo will be used like a salvation bracelet in order to share the gospel.

Each pin costs about 50 cents. We have ordered 80,000 and hope that the kids of Kentucky will participate by donating their VBS missions offering to the cause!

Each church that participates will be sent a pin and an explanation of the use of the pin. This will enable the children to see the pin up close. We hope to be able to order enough so that the children can order one for themselves but aren't sure if we will be able to do so.

The hope is that the kids will get excited about sharing the gospel with the world when it comes to Kentucky. Even the smallest child can share the gospel with one person by paying for a pin. They will also enjoy being a part of something big when the games are finally here.
